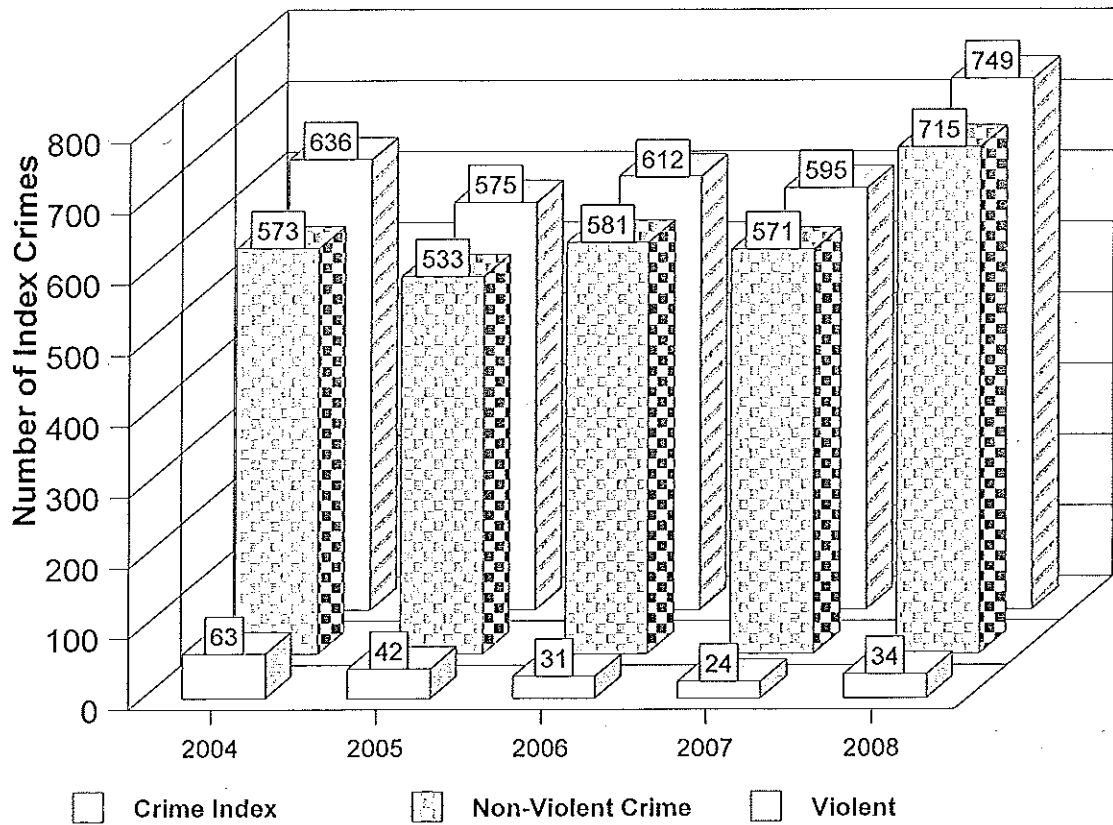

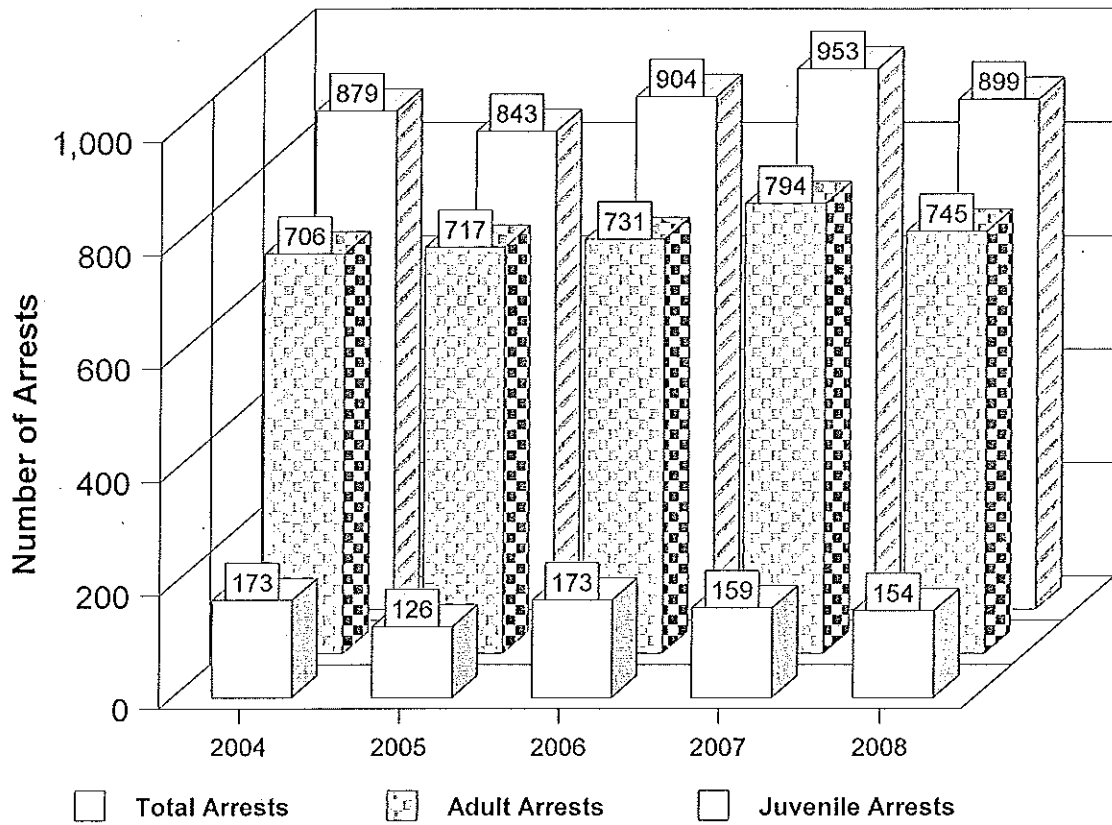

The following statements are based on a reported 89 police officers as of October 31, 2007, and a 2007 estimated population of 52,577.

Ocean Township would need sixteen (16) additional police officers to attain the rate of Ocean County. Forty-two (42) additional police officers would be needed to attain the rate of the state.
